SECOND FLOOR THE NORTH CHAMBER

Use: A bed chamber used by family members and/or servants. Originally at west end of main house

Original Features: Floor frame evidence of former stair below, Muster Room closet lock in partition, doors, hardware.

Later Alterations: Second floor rear added ca. 1810s; extensive decay caused rebuilding ca. 1911, again 2007-9.

Restorations: Ca. 1810s framing duplicated, 6-over-9 windows restored to match evidence for originals.

Furniture: Four muskets, some with bayonets, may have been stored in locked closet; sold at auction 1808.

Finishes: Early plaster south wall; plain board partitions originally unpainted, painted in 19th-20th centuries.
